This unique boutique resort continues to marvel with its prime location above the Pansea Beach, amidst a coconut grove on the isle of Phuket. The essence of its name, “Peaceful Place”, is reflected in the graceful service and the natural beauty of its surrounding, creating an ambiance of tranquillity.

The private pavilions, some with private pools, and villas, are scattered gracefully throughout the coconut grove with each pavilion offering an expansive setting with an outdoor sala and sun deck. The villas lie adjacent to the resort, most with oceanfront settings, featuring Thai inspired décor.

At the centre of Amanpuri is the resort’s midnight blue fresh water pool overlooking the turquoise waters of the Andaman Sea. The Terrace Restaurant serves Thai and European cuisine all-day in a casual setting. Italian cuisine is offered at the Restaurant, serving dinner year round and lunch during high season.
