In the lush hills above the Ayung River in central Bali, Amandari stays true to the essence of its name “peaceful spirits” with its harmonious atmosphere. Its design reflects a traditional Balinese village with river-stone walkways connecting all to the open-air lobby, inspired by a wantilan or village meeting place.

Each of the free-standing suites, some with private swimming pools, and the Amandari Villa, relays into a private courtyard garden. The suites are fronted by Balinese-style stone gateways and walled in for privacy while floor to ceiling sliding glass doors create a sense of openness.

The Restaurant, overlooking the swimming pool and the Ayung Valley, specializes in Indonesian and Western cuisine. With two open-air massage bales overlooking a serene lily pond, The Amandari Spa rejuvenates with a menu of indulging treatments.

The resort, only a few minutes from Ubud, the cultural capital of Bali, is perfectly situated for guests to explore and experience the essence of Bali’s culture.
